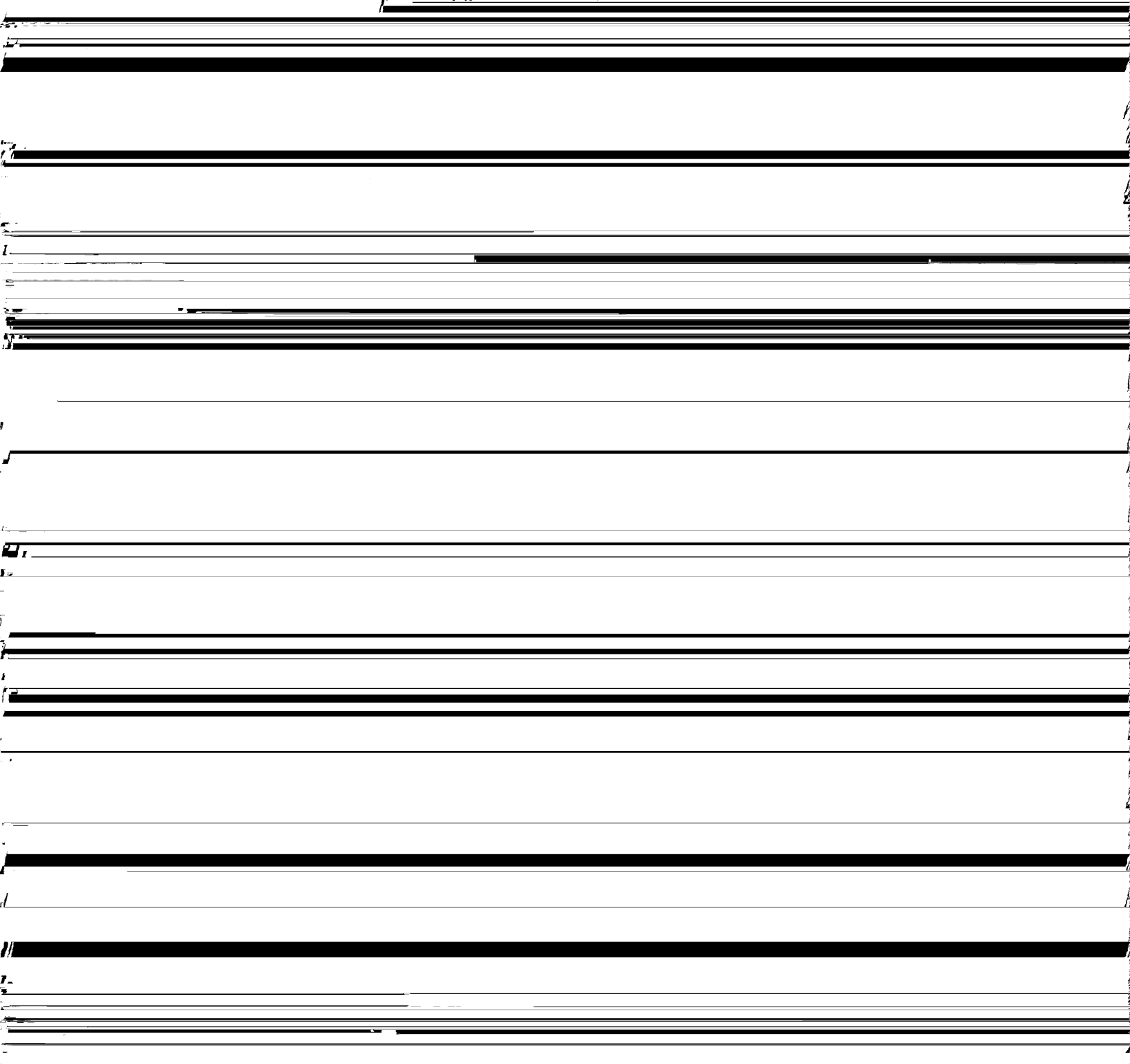
**10.0 PUBLIC COMMENT**
