Background/Rationale: On August 22, 2018, the District received a letter from the Sacramento County Office of Education informing the District that the 2018-19 Budget had been disapproved. In accordance with Education Code 42127d, the District had been appointed an independent Fiscal Advisor that worked with the District in order to address the deficiency in the subsequent year budget. The budget disapproval also qualified the District to receive independent auditing supports from FCMAT at no cost to the District. 


