Founded by Dick Fischer, a former school district transportation director in California, the first NSBSW was held in 1970. In 1975, the <u>National Association for Pupil Transportation</u> (NAPT) was founded.

The NAPT, along with the National School Transportation Association (NSTA) and National Association of State Directors of Pupil Transportation Services (NASDPT), hosts National Bus Safety Week each year.
