<u>Background/Rationale</u>: To provide an update regarding the work being done to address chronic absenteeism and student attendance through the Be HERE Grant.

<u>Financial Considerations</u>: The Be HERE program is fully funded through the Learning Communities for School Success Program Grant from CDE which will end in June 2020. The Enrollment and Attendance Center is in the process of adding an additional support position through Title IV monies for the 2019-2020 school year. Prior to 2017, there were only 1.5 FTE from general funds allocated to attendance work. The grant enabled the District to hire 2 FTE in the EAC and 1 FTE in Student Support Services through June of 2020.
