All plans proposed should include detailed billing. All expenses must be included in the unit/extended costs. Installation costs should take into account after hours work. The Sacramento City Unified School District will make no additional compensation to the selected vendor for these after-

10. EVIDENCE OF RESPONSIBILITY: Upon the request of the District

District may, at its option, annul and set aside the contract, either in whole or in part, and may enter into a new contract in accordance with law for furnishing such item. Any additional cost or expense incurred by the District in the making of such contract or any additional cost of supplying an item by reason of the failure of the Bidder, as described in this paragraph, shall be paid by the Bidder or his surety.

19. INSPECTION OF ITEMS FURNISHED:

- a. The protest must contain a complete statement of any and all bases for the protest.
- b. The protest must refer to the specific portions of all documents that form the bases for the protest.
- c. The party filing the protest must have actually submitted a bid. A bidder may not rely on the bid protest submitted by another bidder, but must timely pursue his or her own protest.
- d. The protest must include the name, address and telephone number of the person representing the protesting party.
- e. The party filing the protest must concurrently transmit a copy of the protest and any attached documentation to all other parties with a direct financial interest that may be adversely affected by the outcome of the protest. Such parties shall include all other bidders or proposers who appear to h
